



## **Rental Property Checklist**

### **Established & New Properties**

Expenses incurred on a rental property are only deductible for the period which a Rental income was earned or during the period the rental property was available for rental.

### **New Rental Property Acquisitions**

- Date of acquisition (Purchase contract or offer & acceptance)
- Type of asset – Details
- Stamp duty details (if applicable)
- Search fees
- Settlement fees

### **Rental Property Income**

- Real Estate Agent Annual Statement, if managed by an agent
- Bank Statements for rental income, if self managed

### **Deductible Expenses**

- Rates
- Water
- Land Tax
- General repairs & Maintenance
  - Electrical
  - Plumbing
  - Minor structural repairs – walls, fences, roof tiles etc
  - Keys cut
- Gardening Expenses
- Pool Cleaning costs
- Insurances
  - Building insurance premium
  - Contents insurance premium (if property rented furnished)
  - Landlord's insurance premium



- Advertising for new tenants
- Lease costs
- Legal expenses – (tenant eviction cost)
- Investment journals
- Interest on loans
- Body corporate fees
- Cleaning fees – Cleaning of carpets, walls etc.
- Bank Charges – BAD Charges, Annual Package Fees, etc.
- Borrowing costs & loan application fees
  - Loan establishment fees
  - Search fees
  - Stamp duty on loan
  - Instrument duties/ fees
  - Mortgage insurance
  - Bank Administration Fees
  - Mortgage Registration Fees
  - Any other loan setup fees
- Pest control expenses (pest control maintenance fees only)
- Travelling (to and from)
  - Seminars & training courses that are rental property related.
  - Rental property for inspections, rent collection, repairs & maintenance, etc.
  - Interstate travel to inspect rental property (not to acquire)
- Accounting and taxation advice & preparation costs
- Capital items over \$300.00 (please list)
  - For example, stove, carpet, furniture, pergola, roof, hot water system, solar system
